



2014 DICE MSc Scholarship

The Durrell Institute of Conservation and Ecology (DICE) at the University of Kent is pleased to announce the launch of the 2014 DICE MSc Scholarship scheme. The successful applicant will receive a fully funded studentship on one of our taught Masters in our Conservation Science and Management programme.

Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Be nationals of or have official refugee status in a country that is officially recognised as [Lower to Upper-Middle Income](#) (as listed below).
- Have at least two years of work experience in the conservation sector.
- Be in possession of a good undergraduate degree, with a minimum of a 2:1 or equivalent.
- Meet the English language requirements as required by UKBA.

Scholarship Details

The Scholarship will cover full tuition fees, a monthly stipend and assistance in travel expenses to and from the UK. The scholarship is for one of the seven Taught Masters Courses offered at DICE (as listed below).

Application Process

Once you have identified a suitable course, please submit a covering letter and a 2 page CV to Postgraduate Admissions Officer Shelley Malekia (S.Malekia@kent.ac.uk) no later than **22.00 (GMT) Sunday 13th April 2014**.
